- Beth is revising the Visitor Guide, Member Handbook, New Member letter and ACC
 Guidelines Maria agreed to review first draft of ACC Guidelines for more consolidation

 Beautification had much better idea!
- 4 picnic tables to be started on in March by shop class @ \$150 each.
- Jacob who is doing the picnic tables also submitted a drawing for a swing set for \$1,370. Keith and committee members believe we can do much cheaper.
- A team blew leaves this past Wednesday and put a good dent in it. Andy is going to go

through on Tuesday with one of the ride tractors and pull the blower behind.

- Check power (Keith).
- Buy deer cameras (Keith).
- Trash Cans Unlimited 2- 34-gallon Landscape Series Outdoor Perforated Trash Can WR-34R w/Anchor Kit (3 Colors) MSRP: \$328.00 Was: \$279.95 Now: \$221.40 (make sure its galvanized metal).
- Potholes in the roads are on Russ's list to be fixed.

- Marsha will check with Mayor Ramey's schedule about attending grand opening. The board should also be there.

Annual Meeting

Other

It was noted that the POA is paying for tv boxes that aren't being used.

- Beth will find out what the committee is getting and then will determine how much more is needed.
- There was discussion about reasons for closing the doors between the lounge and the restaurant. It was mentioned that they were always open but staff chose to keep them closed. An example for keeping them open was last Friday's crowd. The lounge was packed for karaoke and a group of folks came in and left due to the crowd. They may have stayed if we had the overflow in the restaurant. It would be better if that end of the room was remodeled, wrapping the bar around into the restaurant. It is too isolated with the current design.
- It was also mentioned that the lounge needs to be updated, excluding the deck. For the most part, a liquor bottle display is designed to be behind the bar. The display of liquor bottles anywhere else is not needed.
